- B. Daniel 6 – He prayed when it was against the law to pray! He was committed to God, not just when it was convenient, but when it wasn't.

### 3 HEBREW CHILDREN

- A. Daniel 3 Nebuchadnezzar let them have another chance – but listen to what they said Daniel 3:16-18
- B. They put their lives where their mouths were – were thrown into the fiery furnace. But God delivered them – even if God hadn't, they still would have done it anyway

### JESUS!

- B. John 2: Jesus cleansing the temple

- D. The cross – God's greatest proof that He loves us His actions speak so much louder than words.
