 2. We are married to the Lord Romans 7:1-4; 2 Corinthians 11:2

 5. Could we be guilty of this sin and not realize it?
3. The punishment of sin
 1. Under the Old Law it was punishable by death Leviticus 20:10
 2. Under the New Law if not repented of it is Hell fire forever Galatians 5:21; Matthews 5:27-30
