  5. We find that He gave warnings, that are being ignored 22:18-19
2. Who He is verses 13, 16
  1. He is the Alpha and the Omega the A-Z John 1:1-3; Genesis 1:26
  2. He is the Messiah Matthew 1:23; Revelation 22:16
  3. He is the Bright and Morning Star John 1:4-5; 8:12; 9:5
3. He is coming again verses 7, 12
  1. It is called the second coming Hebrews 9:28
  2. It is a promise to all Acts 1:11
  3. It will bring an end to all things 2 Peter 3:10-13
  4. It will initiate the judgment of the world Matthew 25:31-46; Revelation 22:12; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9; 1 Peter 5:4
  5. Your eternal destiny will be sealed at that time. Luke 16:19-31
4. He wants us to be saved verses 14, 17
  1. God has always invited the sinner to come to Him for salvation Isaiah 1:18; 55:6; Matthew 11:28-30
  2. Here is one more invitation verse 17; 2 Peter 3:9
  3. Consider the "who" and the "how" and the "cost" of your salvation.
  4. Man must respond by coming to the blood in the Gospel Matthew 7:21; Revelation 22:14; 7:14
