2. This word in Revelation is the same word as found in Matthew 5
3. The word has the meaning of: "to pronounce happy. It also means supremely blest, fortunate, well off.
4. If we want to be happy, fortunate, or well off then let us study these passages to find out how to be happy, fortunate, or well off.

 1. Life is short Job 14:1-2 James 4:13-15
 2. We are but strangers and pilgrims in this land Hebrews 11:13; 1 Peter 2:11
 3. We will be resurrected John 5:28-29; 1 Corinthians 15:20-23
 4. It is up to us where we go!
3. Blessed is he that watcheth Revelation 16:15
 1. We must always be watching Ezekiel 3:17; Matthew 25:13; 2 Timothy 4:5
 2. To fail to watch is to be committed to hell.
 3. If we watch why do we need to dread the second coming or death?
4. Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper
 1. We are called by the Gospel 2 Thessalonians 2:14; 2 Corinthians 11:2; 1 Peter 1:15; 2 Peter 1:3
 2. How shall we act as the bride?
 3. The fellowship at a marriage feast 1 Corinthians 1:9
5. Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection Revelation 20:6
 1. This may be baptism Romans 6:4
 2. The second death hath no power over these folks.
 3. The second death is found in Revelation 21:8
6. Blessed is he that keepeth the saying of the prophecy of this book Revelation 22:7
 1. We need to let the Word of God dwell in us richly Colossians 3:16
7. Blessed are they that do His commandments Revelation 22:14
 1. These are those who have accepted all that God has said and are keeping them with all of their being!
