1. He is the Son of God, or Servant
 1. John 3:16 as the Son of God
 2. Luke 2:49 He was about His Father's business
 3. As a Servant Isaiah 42:1-9; 52:13-53:12
 4. Glorified John 1:14; 7:39; 12:16; 17:5, 24
2. He is the Holy One
 1. A beautiful accurate description of Jesus, who was truly set apart from worldliness and dedicated to the Lord
 2. Psalm 16:10; Acts 2:27
 3. He did no sin Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 2:21-22
3. He is Just
 1. Meaning of Just is righteous, innocent completely free from guilt
 2. We are justified by faith Romans 5:1, 18; 1 Corinthians 6:11
 3. Christ did no sin Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 2:21-22
 4. The Jews of that day were guilty of denied and killed the sinless Jesus and asked for a murderer in His place Acts 3:14
4. He is the Prince of life
 1. The word "Prince" means originating source, founder or author
 2. Peter is saying the Jesus is the originating source of life John 1:3, 4; 5:26
 3. With this meaning in mind, notice Peter had accused Israel of:
 1. Delivering up Jesus to Pilate who wanted to let His go verse 13
 2. They had denied the Holy and sinless Jesus verse 14
 3. They had asked for a murderer Barabbas verse 15
 4. They had killed the originating source of life verse 15

III Conclusion

1. The reaction of God to this
 1. He raised Jesus from the dead verse 15
 2. He glorified His faithful servant verse 15
2. What were they told to do to remove the guilt that they had verse 19
3. Change and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out
4. You might need to do the same today if so do the same
5. Be baptized for the remission of your sins 2:38
