- 2. Amos is not a prophet by trade, but was called by God to do this work Amos 7:14-15
- 3. He was to prophecy to the northern ten tribes of Israel
- 4. We have three cities mentioned in our text. They play a major role in the history of the Hebrew people.
- 5. The mentioning of these cities would recall memories of what had happen in history to these people.
- 6. We want to study what happened to these cities and make some application to us today.

- 1. Salvation was not through Bethel
 - 1. Bethel is a major city in the life of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob
 - 1. Abraham Genesis 12:8
 - 2. Jacob's
 - 2. We also find that Jeroboam changed God's Worship into calf worship at this place 1 Kings 12:26-33 This better suited him
 - 3. Today we can worship other thing, we can change God's worship to suit ourselves.
 - 1. Covetousness Colossians 3:5 The desire to have more, worship is to kiss toward, Vine to make obeisance, to do reverence to.
 - 2. Idolatry is a work of the flesh Galatians 5:20
 - 3. It is worshipping the created more than the creator Romans 1:25
- 2. Salvation was not in Gilgal
 - 1. Gilgal was the place they worshipped after coming out of Egypt Joshua 4:19; 5:9
 - 2. The reproach of Egypt had been taken away Joshua 5:9
 - 3. But Saul changed the worship of God to what pleased him 1 Samuel 13:8-10; Leviticus 10:1-2; ;Amos 4:4
 - 4. We cannot change the worship of God John 4:24
- 3. Salvation was not in Beersheba
 - 1. Abraham dug wells there and Isaac redug those wells Genesis 21:31; 26:23-25
 - 2. This is in the southern part of the land of Canaan and water was scarce.
 - 3. They had forsaken God who could sustain them Amos 8:11; Jeremiah 2:13; John 6:48; 7:37: Matthew 4:4
 - 4. Have we, sitting in our bed of ease (Amos 6:1, forsaken God?
 - 5. Have we let worship and the house of God lay desolate while we live in our fine houses?
 - 6. Have we forsaken God who can save us and sustain us?
- 4. We are to seek the Lord Amos 5:6
 - 1. While He may be found Isaiah 55:6
 - 2. In His way not ours Jeremiah 10:23; Hebrews 2:3
 - 3. Do we like to hear it but do we like to walk therein Jeremiah 6:16
 - 4. If this is so the results is sin James 4:17
- 5. The results will be disastrous if we do not. Amos 5:6
 - 1. It says break out like fire, this is a simile
 - 2. Hell will be fire Matthew 13:39-41; 25:41; Revelation 20:15
