II Discussion

- 1. Are we sincere with the truth?
 - 1. People are not converted until the heart is reached Romans 6:17
 - 2. The heart or mind is the control center of life and conduct Proverbs 4:23; 23:7
 - 3. When the heart is right, one will be willing to search for the truth Matthew 5:6
 - 4. One will be willing to accept the truth once one finds it Acts 2:41; 4:12; 17:11
- 2. Are we submissive to the truth?
 - 1. If one is sincere with he truth, it will lead him to submit to it.
 - 2. Some say, "Just as long as one is sincere in religion, it doesn't matter what he believes."
 - 3. Ask Naaman if it mattered 2 Kings 5:11, 12
 - 4. Christ was submissive to the truth Philippians 2:8; Hebrews 5:8-9
 - 5. This attitude is taken by anyone who has humbled himself before God Matthew 11:29; Philippians 2:6-7
- 3. Are we sharing the truth?
 - 1. A willingness to share the truth with others is evidence of the fact that one possesses the above attitudes
 - 2. Let us consider some common attitudes toward the lost
 - 1. Complacent
 - 1. This is not a matter of ill-will; it is simply indifference.
 - 2. This is seen in one who is self-satisfied Luke 12:16-21
 - 2. Condescending
 - 1. Here is one who feels superior to those who are lost
 - 2. This is the elder brother's attitude Luke 15:28-30
 - 3. Paul overcame this attitude 1 Corinthians 15:10
 - 4. We all have sinned Romans 3:23
 - 5. There we go except by the grace of God Galatians 6:1
 - 3. Compromising
 - 1. Some what to rationalize and justify those outside of the church
 - 2. All are lost and there is only one way to heaven John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Ephesians 1:3
 - 3. The way to heave is clearly marked John 8:32; Matthew 7:13-14; Hebrews 5:9; Matthew 7:21
 - 4. Compromising the truth will never save the lost, but it will cause the saved to be lost 1 Timothy 4:6; Ephesians 4:15
 - 5. Compassionate
 - 1. We should look at people as God looks at them 1 Peter 2:25; Matthew 9:10-13; Mark 6:30-34
 - 2. How do we treat the word of God?
