1. The destruction is pronounced Verses 1-5
 1. The warning was being sounded Ezekiel 3:15-21
 2. God has given us ample warning of:
 1. The Judgment John 12:48
 2. False teachers Matthew 7:15-19; 1 John 4:1; 1 Timothy 4:1-4
 3. Are we listening?
2. The destruction is described verses 6-12
 1. It will be complete 2 Peter 3:10
 2. There will be no second chance 2 Corinthians 6:2
3. The disapproval is described Verses 13-17
 1. The priest and the prophets job was to declare God's Word
 2. What do we want? 2 Timothy 4:3-4; Revelation 3:17-18; Romans 16:17-18
 3. Where were these people and what did they want
 1. They will not blush no sin was to heinous
 2. They will not walk, they did not want God's way
 3. They will not listen
 4. Do we want what is needed or wanted? What about church discipline, giving, immodest dress, dancing, drinking, smoking?
4. The deserts for desertion verses 18-25
 1. They rejected God verse 19; Hebrews 3:12-13
 2. Their worship was wrong Matthew 15:7-9; John 4:24
5. The demand to repent verses 26-30
 1. When God is wronged repentance is demanded Luke 13:3; Acts 2:38; 3:19; 17:30-31
 2. The church can wrong God; He still wants repentance Revelation 2:5, 16, 22.

III Conclusion

2. We do not have to go through the evils of hell
3. We thus need to listen to God and obey Him.
