    5. Where is our love in this world Matthew 22:37-39; 1 John 2:15-17
    6. The things that caused these people to not accept the invitation are good things, but good things can cause our soul to be lost
  2. They made light of it
    1. They had not regard for the invitation
    2. The Lord has given us an invitation Matthew 11:28-30 how do we feel about it?
    3. Do we feel the privileged to be asked to worship God Psalm 122:1
    3. What excuses could we give for not obeying the commands of God standing beside those who died while doing the commands of God Acts 7; 12; 2 Corinthians 11
  2. Many quit the church
    1. Whom do we have our eyes on, some man 1 Corinthians 1:12-13
    2. Are we friendly Proverbs 18:24; Micah 7:5; John 15:14
    3. No one came to beg me Matthew 11:28-30; Revelation 22:14
  3. Some are not Christians
    1. Some are not saved because all they can “see” is hypocrites in their eyes
    2. Are we practicing what we believe? Are we a stumbling block to others Romans 14:13; 1 John 2:1
    3. If we compare ourselves with ourselves we are not wise 2 Corinthians 10:12
  4. We are to look to Jesus for (why):
    1. Our example 1 Peter 2:21
    2. Our standard Matthew 28:18; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Romans 1:16
    3. Our direction John 14:6; Colossians 3:1-2
    4. Our truth John 1:17; 8:32; 17:17
