 - 1. There are all kinds of work that can be done Matthew 25:31ff; 1 Timothy 5:10; Acts 9:39
 - m. This work is not for our glory but for God's! Matthew 5:16
- n. Do we have room for Christ in our homes?
 - o. Do we talk about Him with our children Ephesians 6:4
- p. Do we have room for Christ in the church?
 - q. We can worship incorrectly Matthew 15:7-9
 - r. All that are not right with Christ will be uprooted Matthew 15:13-14
