  - e. Hearing ye shall hear and shall not understand Matthew 13:13-15 is not what God wants and never has
  - f. They heard and they understood; are you that honest Acts 2:22, 33, 37
  - g. We are equip up for all that we need 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:3
