 - 5. Is this being a Christian? Modest apparel, Worshipping, Drinking adult beverages, Drugs, Dancing.
 - 6. If you know what to do, are you doing it?
- 2. Do we accept the responsibilities of being a Christian?
 - 1. Christians are to be different! 2 Corinthians 6:17; 1 Peter 2:9; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11
 - 2. We do believe that Jesus is the Christ and have obeyed Mark 16:15-16; Acts 2:38; Romans 10:10; 6:3-4
 - 3. Have we obeyed from the heart? Romans 6:17; James 2:17
 - 4. Do we really think fools are: lost, that there is a hell, and that it is real?
 - 5. I know I am to be different, why aren't you different!
- 3. We must live like we know we can be lost
 - 1. We can fall from Grace Galatians 5:4; Romans 16:17-18; 2 John 9-11
 - 2. Other are watching us! Matthew 5:13-16; Spouses, children, parents, grandparents, and friends
 - 3. God is watching 2 Corinthians 5:10
 - 4. I know what you are saying is true, I know I can be lost, but I just want to have fun!
 - 5. Can I change your mind? Live for Jesus!

III Conclusion

- 1. If you see that you need to change, then do so, it is not to late.
- 2. Eternity is a long time, who wants to be with the devil for that length of time?
- 3. If you need to become a Christian now is the time, if you need to come back to Christ now is the time to come back!
