  - 1. Because of the fear of God
    - 1. God is love and there is no fear in love 1 John 4:18
  - 2. Because God can do all things
    - 1. He created all things Genesis 1:1
    - 2. He created man Genesis 1:26
    - 3. Therefore He knows man
  - 3. Because God can destroy it all
    - 1. He can destroy both body and soul in hell Luke 12:5; Matthew 10:28
    - 2. He will destroy it all one day 2 Peter 3:10
  - 4. Because God cares
    - 1. He cares enough to send His Son John 3:16; Romans 5:8-9
    - 2. This Son is the mediator for us 1 Timothy 2:4-5
    - 3. This Son knows our every care Hebrews 4:15; 1 Peter 5:17
    - 4. He cares so much that even the hairs on our head are numbered Luke 12:6-7, 24
  - 5. Because Christ was courageous
    - 1. He did not run from His work John 9:4
    - 2. He did not run from HIs death Isaiah 53:7
    - 3. We are to follow in His steps 1 Peter 2:21

  - 1. By confessing that Jesus is the Christ Luke 12:8-9
  - 2. This is obedience to God
    - 1. Is faith something you do or something God does Ephesians 2:8-10; Romans 10:17; Hebrews 11:6
    - 2. How do we walk in them and do nothing? 1 John 1:7
    - 3. This is not meritous works Titus 3:5
