- 3. It is how we deal with these pressures that makes a difference
- 4. A diamond is not formed unless it submits to pressure!
- 5. From where are we as Christian receiving pressure?

- 1. Christians is under pressure to conform to the world
 - 1. This is a general statement and covers a lot of sins
 - 2. All sins can be classified into three categories 1 John 2:15-17
 - 3. We are not to love the world neither the things in this world 1 John 2:15
 - 4. The world wants us to conform to it 1 Timothy 2:9 (modest)
 - 5. Our youth are to examples of how all are to be toward God 1 Timothy 4:12
 - 6. The Bible tells us our position Romans 12:1-2
- 2. Christians are under pressure to be dishonest
 - 1. We are to provide things honest in the sight of all men Romans 12:17
 - 2. We are to think honest things Philippians 4:8
 - 3. We are to do that which is honest 2 Corinthians 13:7
 - 4. All who are dishonest have their reward Revelation 21:8
- 3. Christians are under pressure to compromise the truth
 - 1. Only the truth will set us free John 8:32
 - 2. Christ has given us the truth John 17:17
 - 3. We are to obey the truth 1 Peter 1:22; we encourage all to obey the truth
 - 4. Some do not love the truth 2 Thessalonians 2:10
 - 5. Some will not obey the truth Romans 2:8
- 4. Christians are under pressure to give up the faith
 - 1. Some will quit 2 Timothy 4:10
 - 2. Paul had to work hard on his faith 1 Corinthians 9:27
 - 3. We must endure to the end to be saved Matthew 10:22; Revelation 2:10
- 5. Christians are under pressure to please men
 - 1. Paul asked if he should please men Galatians 1:10
 - 2. Paul again states that we are not to be men pleasers Ephesians 6:5-6
 - 3. Some preachers are under pressure to please men 2 Timothy 4:1-4
 - 1. Some will be under pressure to change the truth Acts 4:18-22; 5:28-29
 - 4. Some love to hear the praises of men John 12:42-43
- 6. Christians are under pressure to be lukewarm
 - 1. It is easy to be lukewarm Revelation 3:15-16
 - 2. We must be either for or against Him Matthew 12:30
 - 3. No man can serve two masters Matthew 6:24
- 4. We are tp be steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the Lord 1 Corinthians 15:58 III Conclusion
- 1. There is no need to stay under pressure James 4:7
- 2. Remember we will not be under so much pressure that we must give up 1 Corinthians 10:13
- 3. There is a reward in surviving under pressure 1 Peter 1:7
