 - 1. They had not regard for the invitation
 - 2. The Lord has given us an invitation Matthew 11:28-30 how do we feel about it?
 - 3. Do we feel the privileged to be asked to worship God Psalm 122:1
 - 3. What excuses could we give for not obeying the commands of God standing beside those who died while doing the commands of God Acts 7; 12; 2 Corinthians 11
- 2. Many quit the church
 - 1. Whom do we have our eyes on, some man 1 Corinthians 1:12-13
 - 2. Are we friendly Proverbs 18:24; Micah 7:5; John 15:14
 - 3. No one came to beg me Matthew 11:28-30; Revelation 22:14

 - 2. Are we practicing what we believe? Are we a stumbling block to others Romans 14:13; 1 John 2:1

 - 2. Our standard Matthew 28:18; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Romans 1:16
