 - 2. This man wanted to know what to do to have eternal life, and did not like the answer
 - 3. Where is our treasure Matthew 6:19-21
- 5. Where art thou Laodiceans
 - 1. They were lukewarm Revelation 3:15-16
 - 2. They thought that they had need of nothing, but notice what God thought
 - 3. Many today are mistaken about being a Christian Matthew 7:21-23
- 6. Where art thou Simon
 - 1. He was in the gall of bitterness and in the bond of iniquity Acts 8:23
 - 2. This shows that once saved always saved is not true
 - 3. To say that he was not saved is to deny the Scriptures
