 - 4. The wish from John to Gaius is from heavens point of view.

 - 1. Jesus had good health Luke 2:52 (stature, implied)
 - He had to withstand the heaviest loads that mortal man has ever known and His body helped Him carry it as long as it did because of His physical condition, He was a carpenter
 - 2. Our bodies are to be living sacrifices Romans 12:1
 - 3. We are to glorify God in our bodies 1 Corinthians 6:20
 - 4. Paul had to control his physical body 1 Corinthians 9:27
 - 5. Our bodies are the temple of the Holy Ghost 1 Corinthians 19-20
 - 6. We take care of our cars, watches, and other possessions that are important to us, why not our bodies

 - 1. Jesus also advanced in wisdom Luke 2:52
 - 2. Joseph had wisdom Acts 7:9-10
