 - A. The rich man lost his opportunity. Luke 12:19-20
 - B. Many will miss the opportunity to enter the strait gate. Luke 13:24-30
 - C. God will withdraw the door of opportunity. Zechariah 7:11-13; Hosea 4:6; Job 21:14; Proverbs 1:24-25; Romans 1:18-24: 2 Thessalonians 2:10
