1. Text Matthew 28:5-7
2. Easter is found in the KJV of the Bible in Acts 12:4. It is Passover
3. Passover and Easter are not the same
 - a. Easter is always upon the first day of the week
 - b. Passover could be any day of the week Exodus 12:2-6 when a day is mentioned like this it can fall on any day of the week, not always on the same day. July 4 can fall on any day of the week.
 - c. You can google this while I am preaching if you wish and lose the point of the sermon all together.
4. The Resurrection of the Lord was on the first day of the week and we celebrate this every first day of every week Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 16:1-2; 11:17-20

1. Come Matthew 28:6
 - a. Greek is imperative. Come now, come hither
 - b. On the way to the tomb Mark 16:1-3
 - c. The women were told to come Matthew 28:6
 - d. This has always been the invitation of the Scriptures
 - i. Genesis 7:1 Noah and his family
 - ii. Isaiah 55:1-3 come to the Lord
 - iii. Matthew 11:28-30 Come unto Me
 - iv. John 1:46
 - v. John 4:29
 - vi. Revelation 22:17 Spirit and bride say come
 - e. Do you need to come to the Lord
 - i. Have you been burdened with the awfulness of your sins
 - ii. Have you labored
 - iii. Jesus says to come, the tomb is still empty, He is risen!
 - iv. Jesus says to come to Him and live to enter into heaven

2. See Matthew 28:8
 - a. Greek is imperative
 - b. Come see the place where He laid
 - c. There is a difference between look and see, when you look at something you may not grasp, comprehend or understand. This is the meaning of the Greek word
 - d. The angel wanted these woman to grasp, understand and comprehend that the tomb was empty
 - e. Do we see the empty tomb or do we just look at the empty tomb?
 - f. The tomb was empty, now what does that mean for the world, but what about us, here today
 - g. Consider Romans 10:9-10
3. Go Matthew 28:7
 - a. To go from one place to another
 - b. Do you realize that the women were the first to tell of the resurrection?
 - c. There is the responsibility to get busy for the Lord Go
 - d. They had the responsibility not in a public way but in a private way to tell the story of Jesus Acts 8:4 (context men and women, they went)
 - e. Jesus did not want them to stare continually into the empty tomb but to tell the apostles
 - f. What are we to do when we see the empty tomb
 - g. We need to go tell Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; 1 Peter 3:15
4. Tell Matthew 28:7
 - a. He is risen from the dead
 - b. The tomb was empty and still is to this day, no other religious followers can say this
 - c. This is the Gospel 1 Corinthians 15:1-3
 - d. This is what we are to be telling the world Mark 16:15
