- 2. Discipline is only used one time in the King James Version Job 36:10; 2 times in the New King James Proverbs 15:10; 1 Corinthians 9:27
- 3. While the word is not used much the idea is, it is the idea of self-control or temperate; training, instruction.
- 4. While we do have liberty, we do not have the liberty to do anything. 1 Corinthians 9:19-23

 - f. Paul was telling Timothy the correct way to exercise 1 Timothy 4:7-8
 - g. There are some things that need to be put off in order to run correctly in this race Hebrews 12:1-2
- h. Commitment is needed to run this race
 - i. Is temperate in all things I Corinthians 9:25
 - j. The training to use the Armor provided Ephesians 6:10-18
 - k. The battle is forward and hard 2 Timothy 2:3-5
- 1. Endurance is needed to run this race
 - m. I therefore so run... 1 Corinthians 9:26-27
 - n. We cannot quit nor give up
 - o. We cannot do anything to be disqualified during the race Exodus 32:32-33; 1 Corinthians 10:12; Galatians 5:4; 2 Peter 2:20-22
 - p. We must endure till the end Matthew 24:13; 2 Timothy 2:3, 10; 4:3, 5; James 5:11 (Paul was an example of one who endured all things to have the crown 4:8)
