- 1. 2 Peter 1:4
- 2. Consider the word precious
 - 1. Meaning: of great value or high price; 2) Highly esteemed or cherished; 3) excessively refined.
 - 2. Some things are precious because of value: gold, silver, and jewels, something hard to fine.
 - 3. Some things are precious because of who owned them: one else may say that it is worthless, but to another it is priceless because of who owned it.
 - 4. The word "precious" is used 7 times in 1 & 2 Peter
- 3. Promises
 - 1. Promises are made in marriage, business and politics
 - 2. Some promises are not kept because: 1) difficulties of keeping promise, or circumstances that prevent keeping of a promise
 - 3. God is able and willing to keep His promise 2 Peter 3:9
