 - b. We are fighting the same battle today 1 John 2:15-17
 - c. We must remember that the pleasures of sin are but for a season Hebrews 11:25
 - d. French Fries do have their appeal, but broccoli is the right choice!
- 2. The church is in this battle also
 - a. The true church loses the battle Matthew 7:13-14
 - b. But the biblical church has it rewards 2 Corinthians 4:18; 1 John 2:25
 - c. Yet many would rather have their senses tickled rather than have the truth 2 Timothy 4:2-4
 - d. French fries do have their appeal, but broccoli is the right choice!
