    - d. It was a place of plenty, walled cities and giants Numbers 13:27-33; Joshua 14:12
    - e. It was a place of promise Joshua 14:9
    - f. It was a place of refuge Joshua 20:7; 21:11, 13
    - g. It was a place of the king 2 Samuel 2:1; 5:1, 5
  - 2. The faith of Caleb
    - a. God had promised them a land that flowed with milk and honey Leviticus 20:24
    - b. He followed God wholly 14:8, 9, 14
    - c. He followed the God fully Numbers 14:24
    - d. He faced giants Numbers 13:28, 30
    - e. He faced stoning Numbers 14:10
    - f. He believed what God said, but he understood that he had to do something to receive the blessing
  - 3. The commission of Caleb
    - a. He was willing Numbers 13:30; Some are willing but do nothing
    - b. He did Numbers 14:24; Joshua 14:14
    - c. He had faith that God was capable of doing as He has promised Romans 4:20-21; Hebrews 6:18
    - d. He did not close his eyes to the facts
      - i. He did not deny the cities were walled
      - ii. He did not deny the giants were there
      - iii. It was hard, we have hard work before us, what will we do?
    - e. He was not afraid to do what God said to do. 1 Timothy 6:12; 2 Corinthians 10:4; Ephesians 6:11-14; 2 Timothy :3-4
