  - a. This is first before a father Matthew 19:4-5; Hebrews 13:4 Too many today are getting the father first and then maybe becomes a husband. This is not a biblical approach to the family.
  - b. He has the right to marry and become a father. Matthew 19:9; 1 Corinthians 7:2
  - c. Love his wife Ephesians 5:23-33
  - d. Dealing correctly with his wife 1 Peter 3:7 above passages as well

  - a. He has taught 1 Timothy 3:2; Acts 6:3, 5; 21:8-9
