- 1. Hebrews 4:14
- 2. We know from our previous studies that there are things that Hinder New Testament Christianity
- 3. We know that we can let the slip or we can drift from our harbor, but we have an anchor
- 4. In today study we find that we are to hold fast
 - a. The phrase "hold fast" is found 8 times in the KJV
 - b. There are other phrases that have the same meaning such as, "stand fast" and "lay hold"
 - c. The meaning of our words today are "to cling tenaciously to"
 - d. There are things that we need to "hold fast onto" and never let them go

II Discussion

- 1. We are to hold fast onto that which is good 1 Thessalonians 5:21
 - a. We are to properly test all things; i.e. gather all the evidence in regard to that biblical problem, then make the necessary and correct conclusion
 - b. Once we know the truth we are to be faithful in living in harmony with that truth
 - c. We then must abstain from the evil of this world.
- 2. We are to hold fast the form of sound words 2 Timothy 1:13; Revelation 3:3
 - a. The word "form" is the word "pattern" 1 Timothy 1:16; Romans 6:17; Hebrews 8:5
 - b. "Sound" means healthy as opposed to sick, deadly, perverted or false doctrine
 - c. The proper attitude in faith and in love (together not separated from each other)
- 3. We are to hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end Hebrews 3:6
 - a. Christ is the head over His own house 1 Timothy 3:15
 - b. There are demand of living within this house 1) hold fast 2) confidence 3) hope 4) firm unto the end of our lives
 - c. We must take these truths into our hearts and heads
 - d. We must build upon the hopes of happiness of these truths
 - e. We must make a profession of these truths
 - f. We must live up to these truths
 - g. We must walk closely, consistently, courageously and constantly.
- 4. We are to hold fast to our profession Hebrews 4:14; 10:23 (without wavering)
 - a. New King James has Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering 10:23. also confession 4:14
 - b. The good confession of 1 Timothy 6:16; Acts 8:38; Matthew 10:32-33
 - c. A life long commitment to God
 - d. Because He is faithful that promised 2 Peter 3:9; Titus 1:2
- 5. We are to hold fast until Christ comes again Revelation 2:25
 - a. Some at Thyatira were not involved with the work of Satan
 - b. These are the one encouraged to hold fast
 - c. The Lord will not place on anyone more than they can bear Matthew 11:28-30; 1 Corinthians 10:13; Philippians 4:13

III Conclusion

- 1. We have an sin which will so easily beset us but we have an anchor of the soul
- 2. We are to hold fast when temptations blow upon our ship
- 3. Do you have an anchor, a hope of the soul

4. Are you holding fast and will you hold fast until the end
