 - a, He prayed to God about the frogs Exodus 8:5-15
 - b. He prayed that God forgive Israel for making the golden calf Exodus 32:11-13;

- d. He prayed that the Lord would heal Miriam of leprosy Numbers 12:12-13

 - c. He prayed all night 1 Samuel 15:11

 - a. When blessed he sat before the Lord in prayer 2 Samuel 7:18-20
 - b. When the child was sick 2 Samuel 12:16
- 5. Solomon when becoming king talked with God 1 Kings 3:5-10
- 6. Daniel prayed when he knew it was illegal to pray Daniel 6:10

 - a. Following His baptism Luke 3:21
 - b. Before selecting the apostles He prayed Luke 6:12 ff

 - 1. Jesus prayed to be glorified 1-5
