## Introduction

1. John 1:29-36
2. The entire book of John contains evidence to convince the honest heart that Jesus is the Christ the Son of God John 20:30-31
3. This book contains testimony of John the Baptist
  - a. He was sent from God 1:15, 19-23 (Isaiah 40:3-5)
  - b. His testimony is important because he points to the fulfillment of prophecies
4. Let us notice three things about this Lamb

## II Discussion

1. The significance of the Lamb
  - a. The Passover lamb was a type of Christ Exodus 12:3-11
    - i. The blood had to be applied
    - ii. The blood saved them from death
    - iii. Christ is our Passover Lamb 1 Corinthians 5:7
      1. We must have the blood applied Revelation 1:5; Romans 6:3-4
      2. We are saved from death by His blood Romans 6:23
  - b. The sacrificial lambs of the Leviticus system were a type of Christ Exodus 29:38-39
  - c. The lamb in prophecy Isaiah 53:4-7
2. The Sacrifice of the Lamb
  - a. Jesus is identified as “the Lamb of God”
    - i. The other sacrificial lambs were brought by men
    - ii. Jesus is God’s sacrifice for sin
  - b. The “purpose” is to “take away the sin”
    - i. The blood of animals provided atonement in anticipation Hebrews 10:1-4
    - ii. Christ’s blood provides atonement in the absolute Hebrews 9:24-28; 1 Peter 1:18-19
    - iii. Christ is a sin-offering 2 Corinthians 5:21
  - c. “The sin of the world”
    - i. All the world would be blessed by His coming Genesis 12:1-3
    - ii. It was for all flesh Isaiah 40:5
    - iii. God so loved the World John 3:16
  - d. This ought to reveal to us the seriousness of sin
  - e. This ought to cause man to realize that man cannot save himself Romans 5:6-9; Jeremiah 10:23
  - f. Instead of trying to rationalize way our own sins, this should cause us to respond to the Lamb, the Redeemer 1 Peter 1:18-19; Romans 2:4; 6:3-4
3. Salvation is through the Lamb
  - a. We are redeemed with the precious blood of Christ 1 Peter 1:18-19
  - b. We are redeemed from all iniquity by the blood of Christ Titus 2:14
  - c. Redemption is through His blood Ephesians 1:7; Colossians 1:14
  - d. It will cleans us from all our sins 1 John 1:7

1. Jesus as the Lamb of God show God’s love and concern for humanity

2. The only way to God is through the Lamb of God which will take away your sins
