- 2. In our society there is much to-do about gaining attention.
 - a. The way we wear our hair
 - b. The clothes that we wear
 - c. The car that we drive
- 3. The only one whose attention that really matters is God's.
- 4. In our striving to get attention there are some things to avoid, just are there some things that will get the attention of God.

II Discussion

- 1. Things to avoid
 - a. Seeking to be seen of men Matthew 6:1-4
 - i. These three things discussed were the cardinal works of Jewish religion
 - ii. The only purpose was to be seen of men about how pious these individuals were.
 - iii. God wants us to help the poor, to have a relationship with Him and to mortify the flesh
 - b. Structure over Substance 1 Corinthians 2: 1-5
 - i. Structure is important but when we are emphasizing it over substance it our structure can become ritualistic.
 - ii. Words are important Colossians 4:6
 - c. Personal success yet ignoring where true success originates Daniel 4:28-37
 - d. Trying to look good without doing well 1 Samuel 15:10-23; Ephesians 6:6
 - e. Trying to substitute for what was requested Matthew 25:224-29
 - f. Coveting privilege rather than service Luke 14:7-11
- 2. Getting God's attention
 - a. Unassuming service Matthew 25:37-39 (When saw we hungry, thirsty, or naked)
 - b. Integrity of heart Psalm 15
 - c. Submission to God's authority rather than relying on personal status Matthew 8:8-13 (centurion, Lord, I am not worthy)
 - d. Priorities allowed to over pride Matthew 15:21-28 (Woman of Canaan, daughter to be healed)
 - e. Costly trust Mark 12:41-44 (widow's mite)

III Conclusion

- 1. We admire godly men and women, but we can be reluctant to pay the price associated with godliness
- 2. We may allow our heads to be turned and take unacceptable shortcuts by worldly priorities.
- 3. We must not only talk a good game of Christianity but we must play a good game of Christianity.
- 4. We can obtain the attention of God, by submission to His will.
