- 1. Acts 9:1-2; 31 NKJV (has peace and were edified)
- 2. Christians have been and are inconvenienced
 - a. The church was being persecuted Acts 8:1
 - b. When we have inconvenience with no A/C or electricity what do we do?
 - c. The Christians in Acts 9:2 feared for their lives because of their worship to God
- 3. Yet, when peace came the church still grew. Acts 9:31 NKJV
 - a. We all have trials in our Christian life; we all have peace.
 - b. When peace comes, what we do will make the difference
- 4. Let us look at the rewards of peace, then the responsibility of peace, and finally the results of peace.

- 1. The rewards of peace James 1:2-4
 - a. When we are in the midst of trials our resources are depleted, our mind are focused on certain things and we leave other things undone. Matthew 13:21; Luke 8:14
 - b. Our resources become lost Matthew 5:6 we lose the hungering and thirsting Matthew 5:6
 - c. Yet when peace comes (Philippians 4:7) it is time to rebound resupply our resources Acts 20:32
 - d. It is time for us to grow during peace 1 Peter 2:2; 2 Peter 3:18
 - i. Grow in joy James 1:2
 - ii. Grow in steadfastness 1 Corinthians 15:58
 - iii. Grow in lessons self examination 2 Corinthians 13:5; 1 Corinthians 11:28
 - 1. Did I bring this onto myself?
 - 2. Did I complain
 - 3. Did I handle this in the proper manner?
 - 4. Did I do what was right
 - iv. Grow in fellowship with God and fellow Christians? 1 John 1:3,6; 2Corinthians 1:4
- 2. The responsibility when peace comes
 - a. Resist to quit 2 Timothy 4:10 Demas
 - b. Lay hold on eternal life 1 Timothy 6:11-12
 - c. Make our calling and election sure 2 Peter 1:10
 - d. Where we go depends on how we react
- 3. The results of peace Philippians 4:7
 - a. Putting into action the responsibility of peace
 - b. We share the blessings of peace Ecclesiastes 12:13
 - c. We have the peace of God that passes all understanding, we share that peace Philippians 4:7
 - d. This is a fulfillment of Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16
 - e. We are thus practicing Pure religion James 1:27
 - f. We will learn to love one another

- 2. The devil does not quit 1 Peter 5:8

- 3. What will we do when peace comes?
 - a. Will we have the rewards of peace and place them into action
 - b. We will then have the responsibility of peace
