- 1. Acts 1:9-11
- 2. This is the most important event in the history of mankind
 - a. The death was important
 - b. The resurrection declares Him to be the Son of God Romans 1:4; 1 Timothy 3:16
 - c. The apostles reacted to this event with great joy, praising and blessing God Luke 24:52-53; Mark 16:19
- 3. The world celebrates this event one time a year, the church every Sunday 1 Corinthians 11:26
- 4. Our faith in Christ ought to affect our conduct 1 Timothy 3:15
 - a. Faith is built upon evidence; the resurrection has proof
- 5. The book of Hebrews emphasizes the ascension, let us study what it says about it II Discussion
 - 1. Hebrews 1:3 He is sat down on the right hand of God
 - a. Sat means to cause to sit down appoint
 - b. God the Father caused the Son to sit down at His right hand and He was appointed to do so before the foundations of the world
 - c. As such He is our Mediator redeemer,
 - d. He has the highest honor
 - e. Authority is His
 - 2. Hebrews 4:14; Hold fast because of our High Priest
 - a. He is greater than Aaron or any of his order
 - b. Once a year the Aaronic order went into the Most Holy Place but Christ is entered into heaven
 - i. Pleading our cause
 - ii. Presenting His offering
 - iii. For His people who are priest
 - c. He is touched by our problems because
 - i. He was tempted as we are
 - ii. Because of this we are to hold fast
 - iii. This is the background for the next 2 points
 - 3. Hebrews 6:16-19 Hope
 - a. Hope is set before us verse 18 same as above
 - b. The hope is set before us because He has entered heaven, (within the veil)
 - c. This hope is our anchor of the soul
 - 4. Hebrews 8:1 High Priest
 - a. He is our High Priest after the order of Melchisedec
 - b. Who had no father, mother, descent, beginning or end 7:3, 11, 13-17, 19, 21
 - c. Our High Priest is so much better than the old Levitical
 - d. Hebrews 9:24
 - e. He is appearing before God for us
 - f. His was a better sacrifice than the Levitical sacrifices 9:23
 - g. Hebrews 10:12
 - h. Offered one sacrifice for us
 - i. The emphasis is upon the one sacrifice not the many 9:11-14
 - 5. Hebrews 12:1-2 Author and Finisher
 - a. The race is set before us, the race is marked with limits and direction

- b. We are to run this race with patience and perseverance
- c. Nothing passes between heaven and earth but by Him
- d. Look to Him as our
 - i. Example
 - ii. Encourager
- e. Look to Him for our
 - i. Direction
 - ii. Assistance
 - iii. Acceptance
