Day of Worship Sabbath or Sunday, Which?

Introduction

- 1. Deuteronomy 5:1-3
- 2. Under the Old Testament day of worship was the Sabbath Deuteronomy 5:12-15; under the New Testament the day of worship is the first day of the week Acts 20:7
- 3. This is why we must understand the elimination of the Old and the establishment of the New
- 4. Many are confused about this and it has caused no small dilemma for many in the religious world.
- 5. Let us study this important matter together.

II Discussion

- 1. The Sabbath
 - a. What was delivered
 - i. Because of Israel's deliverance from bondage Deuteronomy 5:12-15
 - ii. This law was given after the deliverance from Egyptians bondage. Deuteronomy 5:3
 - iii. This day was ordained during the time of Moses and the patriarch did not keep it.
 - b. Who observed this Law
 - i. It was a sign between God and Israel Exodus 31:13-17; Deuteronomy 5:1-3
 - ii. It was not a sign between all nations, just between God and Israel.
 - c. When did the Sabbath end
 - i. Some claim that it was "perpetual" Exodus 31:16
 - ii. It is no more "perpetual" than animal sacrifice and burning of incenses.
 - iii. The covenant with Israel was prophesied to be annulled Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 8:6-9; Hebrews 9:15-17;
 - iv. It was nailed to the cross Colossians 2:14
 - v. It was abolished Ephesians 2:15
 - vi. If one keeps the Sabbath today they are fallen from Grace. Galatians 5:4
 - vii. There is a New and an Old 2 Corinthians 3:11, 13, 14, 15-17
- 2. The Lord's Day
 - a. Why is the day important
 - i. It is the day the Lord rose from the grave. Matthew 28:1; Mark 16:2; Luke 24:1, 13, 20-21; John 20:1, 19, 24, 26
 - ii. It was the day the church was established Acts 2:1; Leviticus 23:15-16
 - iii. It was the day the Holy Spirit and the power came Acts 1:8; 2:1-4
 - iv. The Gospel was preached on this day Acts 2:22-36
 - v. It is called the Lord's day Revelation 1:10
 - b. What day the early church worshipped upon
 - i. Broke bread Acts 20:7
 - ii. Gave 1 Corinthians 16:1-2
 - c. How often did the early church meet
 - i. The came together 1 Corinthians 11:18, 20, 33
 - ii. It was every first day of every week Remember the Sabbath and keep it holy

iii. We are not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together Hebrews 10:25; Acts 2:46; 4:23-24, 32; 5:42; 6:1
