- 2. There is much confusion about the church today
- 3. We have been told to "join the church of your choice."
- 4. Since the Bible is our source of authority in all things religious let us see what it has to say about the matter

## II Discussion

- 1. There is only one church of Christ
  - a. Ephesians 4:4 there is one body!
  - b. Ephesians 1:22-23 This body is the church.
- 2. The church would be established in the last days Isaiah 2:2-3
  - a. This tells us when
  - b. This passage tells us where the church would begin Jerusalem on Mt. Zion
  - c. This has been fulfilled Acts 2:17; 2:5; 1:4
- 3. It would be established in the days of "these kings" Daniel 2:44
  - a. The dream and its interpretation Daniel 2:38
  - b. Four world powers were to come into play
    - i. Babylon was the first Daniel 2:38
    - ii. Medo-Persian was second Daniel 5:31
    - iii. The next kingdom is the Grecian Alexander the Great
    - iv. The last is the Roman kingdom Luke 2:1; Acts 11:28
- 4. It was preached as being "at hand"
  - a. John the Baptist preached that the kingdom was "at hand." Matthew 3:2
  - b. Jesus preached the same message Matthew 4:17
- 5. The kingdom would come during their life time and with power Mark 9:1
  - a. God cannot lie Titus 1:2
  - b. So the kingdom has come or there are people on this earth over 2,000 years old, which do you believe.
  - c. Notice also that this passage says the kingdom would come with power.
  - d. When the Holy Ghost came the power would come Acts 1:5, 7-8
  - e. This happened Acts 2:1-5
- 6. The church and the kingdom are used interchangeably Matthew 16:13-18
  - a. Jesus said that he would build His church, future tense
  - b. The Rock is Christ the foundation Matthew 7:24-27; 1 Corinthians 10:4
  - c. Peter is the main speaker in Acts 2 and 10
- 7. The preaching that would be involved in the kingdom Luke 24:46-48
  - a. They were in Jerusalem proven already
  - b. When asked what to do about their sins, the apostles answered with repentance and remission of sins Acts 2:38
- 8. After Acts 2 the church/kingdom is spoken of as being already in existence
  - a. Revelation 1:9 John was in the kingdom
  - b. We can be translated from the power of darkness into the kingdom of His dear Son Colossians 1:13
  - c. Paul was teaching Timothy how to behave in the church 1 Timothy 3:15
  - d. The church was being persecuted Acts 8:1, 4
