  - a. They were warned of their evil ways Zech 1:4; 2 Kings 17:13
  - b. Their attitude was we will turn from our evil ways Jeremiah 6:16
  - c. When truth is taught what is our attitude toward it 2 Timothy 4:1-4
- 2. Pride
  - a. This action God hates Proverbs 8:13;
  - b. Pride is before destruction Proverbs 16:18
  - c. It is condemned 1 John 2:16
  - d. Some want the preeminence 3 John 9-11 Adam Clarke said, "this man behaved himself haughtily in it." He was a church officer.
- 3. Arrogant
  - a. This is the spirit that comes with improper knowledge 1 Corinthians 8:1-2
  - b. Paul describes this attitude Colossians 2:18ff
  - c. This spirit can be displayed by how we treat the world or an erring member Galatians 6:1-3
  - d. Jesus did not tell us to not get the beam out of our brother's eye, he told us first to get the mote out of our own eye then we can see how to get the beam out of our brother's eye. Matthew 7:1-5
- 4. Sectarian
  - a. The Lord hates this kind of spirit Proverbs 6:16-19
  - b. This is the kind of spirit that likes to follow a person 1 Corinthians 1:10-13; 3:3-9
  - c. It is the kind of spirit that likes to start another church when there is no need to.
  - d. This the kind of spirit not what Jesus prayed for John 17:20-21
  - e. This is not the kind of spirit we are to be working for Ephesians 4:3
- 5. Laziness
  - a. The one talented man was "wicked and slothful" Matthew 25:26
  - b. If a man does not work, he should not eat 2 Thessalonians 3:10-13
  - c. Hebrews exhorts us not to be slothful but workers Hebrews 6:10-12
  - d. There is the work of an evangelist 2 Timothy 4:5;
  - e. There is work for all 1 Corinthians 15:58; Philippians 2:12
- 6. Pseudo-knowledge
  - a. To think one is a scholar does not make him so Galatians 6:3
  - b. James describes this kind of wisdom and calls it earthly, sensual and devilish James 3:14-16
  - c. Paul says that he knows nothing as he ought to know 1 Corinthians 8:2
  - d. We can know if a person has this kind of knowledge 1 John 2:43-4
