 - d. Understand what your reward will be if you do not obey 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9
- 3. I want to be saved like the thief on the cross Luke 23:39-43
 - a. You nor anyone else in the world cannot be save like the thief on the cross
 - b. What saved this thief? Jesus
 - i. Jesus did and does have the right to forgive sins Luke 5:18-21
 - ii. Baptism had nothing to do with this thief being saved
 - iii. This man died before the law of Christ this includes Christ baptism became effective. Matthew 28:19-20
 - c. He did know some things; he knew about the kingdom Matthew 4:17
 - d. There is not a person today who can be saved without baptism 1 Peter 3:21
- 4. Someone in my family was not baptized therefore I will not be baptized
 - a. When we stand before God, what a family member has done will not matter! 2 Corinthians 5:10
 - b. Listen to a family member who did not respond to the Word of God. Luke 16:23-
 - c. By your non-obedience, it will not save yourself nor your family member. You can save yourself Acts 2:40
- 5. Remember some things about delaying your response to the Lord's invitation to be saved.
 - a. Your conscience can become seared 1 Timothy 4:2
 - b. You can be sent a strong delusion and believe a lie 2 Thessalonians 2:10-12
 - c. Yes God does give up on some people Romans 1:24, 26, 28
 - d. What kind of heart do you have?
