 - b. Our correct thinking is a cure Proverbs 23:7
 - i. Philippians 4:13 What we think we can do we can do
 - ii. Romans 8:28 we know these things to be so
 - c. Our work is a cure for doubt 1 Corinthians 15:58
 - i. Elijah becomes discouraged after the battle with the prophets of Baal 1 Kings 19:4
 - ii. The cure was to take care of physical, the spiritual, then get to work 4-18
- 3. What is the conclusion of doubt
 - a. It can cause fear and keep us from doing what God wants and demands Matthew 25:25-30
 - b. Overcoming doubt by faith Proverbs 3:5
 - c. Overcoming doubt will give us abundant living John 10:10
 - d. Overcoming doubt will give us eternal life John 10:24-28
 - e. Overcoming doubt will give us peace of mind Philippians 4:6-9
