4. Is He your Justifier Romans 3:26
 - a. "To deem to be right," signifies, in the NT, (a) "to show to be right or righteous" (b) "to declare to be righteous, to pronounce righteous," by God concerning men, who are declared to be righteous before Him on certain conditions laid down by Him.
5. Is He your Propitiation Romans 3:25; 1 John 2:2
 - a. A means whereby sin is covered and remitted."
