  - c. Love guides our action 2 Corinthians 5:14; Ephesians 5:2
  - d. We are to love our neighbor as ourselves Matthew 22:39
  - e. We are to love our neighbor John 13:34-35; 1 John 3:16
  - f. We are to love our brothers fervently 1 Peter 1:22
  - g. Love worketh no ill toward our brothers Romans 13:9-10
