 - b. This is us conforming to the revealed will of God Matthew 3:15; Psalm 119:172
 - c. We are to hunger and thirst after it Matthew 5:6
 - d. Some will be persecuted for righteousness sake Matthew 5:10
 - e. Our righteousness ought to exceed other religious folks Matthew 5:20
 - f. We are to seek His righteousness Matthew 6:33
- 2. Godliness
 - a. This is piety characterized by Godward attitude. God-likeness
 - b. Not just an outward form 2 Timothy 3:5
 - c. The man is described who does not consent to wholesome words which is according to godliness 1 Timothy 6:3-5
 - d. Then our attitude is so very important 1 Timothy 6:6
- 3. Faith
 - a. This is firm persuasion Hebrews 11:1, 6
 - b. This attribute comes by hearing the Word of God Romans 10:17
 - c. Thus guided we are to walk by faith 2 Corinthians 5:7
- 4. Love
 - a. The highest form of devotion
 - b. God manifested this to us John 3:16
 - c. Our manifestation of this to God John 14:15
 - d. Our manifestation to others John 13:34-35
- 5. Patience
 - a. An abiding under
 - b. The trial of our faith works patience James 1:3; Romans 5:3
 - c. This means we are to stay the course Romans 2:7
 - d. Not letting go, even when we are at our lowest and not at our best
- 6. Meekness or gentleness
 - a. Strength under control
 - b. Jesus Matthew 11:29; 26:53 (legion is 6,000 or 72,000 angels)
 - i. Remember one angel killed 185,000 men 2Kings 19:35
 - c. The meek shall inherit the earth Matthew 5:5
