 - iii. The Apostles wrote 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 3:15
 - c. To profit from the truth we must know it Ephesians 5:17
 - i. We are and will be destroyed without knowledge Hosea 4:6; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9
 - ii. Truth is the only way to come to God John 6:44-45
 - iii. The truth must be taught Romans 10:13-14
 - d. One must obey the truth 1 Peter 1:22-25
 - e. We must continue or abide in the truth 8:31
 - f. One can be blinded to the truth John 8:43, 47; Matthew 13:14-15
- 2. The truth about freedom
 - a. Freedom implies bondage
 - i. They denied to ever being in bondage Egypt, Babylon, Rome
 - 1. Sin does not control me!
 - ii. They/ we are in bondage to sin John 8:34; Romans 6:16; 2 Peter 2:19; Acts 8:23
 - iii. By the snare of the devil 2 Timothy 2:25-26
 - b. The need for freedom
 - i. One must be convinced he is lost before he can be saved
 - ii. We might make claims like the Jews did John 8:37-39
 - 1. I am a member of the church
 - 2. Do you act like one?
 - 3. Do you act like a child of God or the devil John 8:44
 - iii. One is servant of the one he obeys Romans 6:16
- 3. Liberty is offered
 - a. The Gospel is the law of liberty James 1:25; 2:12
 - b. Liberty does not mean you can do as you please Galatians 5:13; 1 Peter 2:16
 - c. Makes one free from the law of sin and death Romans 8:2; Galatians 5:1
 - d. One can be free from the fleshly desires, the devil, evil conscience the cares of the world and death
