 - d. Hebrews 3:4 God built all things
 - e. Exodus 20:3 no other gods before this God
2. Bible contains errors
 - a. Someone said 2,100 errors in the Bible
 - i. All these can be explained with context and proper reading
 - b. We need to rightly divided the Bible 2 Timothy 2:15
 - c. It is given for doctrine, reproof, and correction, and it is from God 2 Timothy 3:16-17
 - d. Men were not writing what they thought but what God said 2 Peter 1:20-21
3. Is mechanical instrumental of music acceptable to God?
 - a. Christ has all authority Matthew 28:18
 - i. That leaves none for you or me
 - ii. Colossians 3:17
 - b. It is not what some preacher or elders think, but what does the Bible says
 - c. Hebrews 2:12; 13:15 we are to sing
 - d. Ephesians 5:19 gives us the instrument it is the heart Colossians 3:16
 - e. We cannot add to take from God's Word Deuteronomy 4:2; Proverbs 30:6; Revelation 22:18-19
4. Is it our conscience or what the Bible says
 - a. There is a very casual attitude about marriage today
 - b. It is a life time commitment
 - i. Chicken and hog, with chicken it is just a donation but with the pig it is total commitment
 - c. Conscience is not a safe guide Acts 23:1; 7: held the clothes for those killed; 8: made havoc of the church; 1 Timothy 1:13
 - d. There are different views within the church but that is not what God said.
 - e. What God says settles all matters
5. Baptism is it nonessential
 - a. Some are now saying that any form of baptism is acceptable
 - b. The correct purpose and design of baptism is necessary

- ii. Stands between the sinner and remission of sins Acts 2:38
- iii. Stands between the sinner and washing away of sins Acts 22:16
- iv. Stands between the sinner and the blood of Christ,
 - 1. Blood was shed in death John 19
 - 2. Blood washes away sins Revelation 1:5
 - 3. Contact the Blood in baptism Romans 6:3-4
- v. Stands between the sinner and a new life 2 Corinthians 5:17
- vi. Stands between the sinner and the body of Christ Ephesians 4:4; 1:22-23;
1 Corinthians 12:13; Acts 2:47
- vii. Stands between the sinner and being saved 1 Peter 3:21
