## Introduction

- 1. 1 Corinthians 8:1-3
- 2. The context of the chapter is dealing with a "weak brother" this is a Christian that may not have the same knowledge about certain things as another.
- 3. Brethren can be weak in faith without being lost, we must attain to a stronger faith Hebrews 5:12-14
- 4. Christ died for both the weak and strong 1 Corinthians 8:11-12; Romans 14:9-13 thus it becomes How do I treat others
- 5. A number of factors must be taken into account while I am drawing conclusions about another brother
  - a. How long has he been a Christian
  - b. What is his religious background
  - c. How much opportunity has he had to receive solid Bible teaching
  - d. What does he believe
  - e. Why he believes what he believes
  - f. Is this a matter of opinion or salvation
- 6. This is why it is important for us to study God's Word.

- 1. Some knowledge puffeth up 1 Corinthians 8:1
  - a. We are to know some things; this does not mean we have to be timid about these things
    - i. The truth John 8:32
    - ii. We are to know fruits Matthew 7:16,20
    - iii. We can know if we are keeping His commandments 1 John 2:3-4
    - iv. We know we must have faith Hebrews 11:6
    - v. We know that all must repent Acts 17:31
    - vi. We know that all must be baptized to be saved 1 Peter 3:21
    - vii. We know that if the earthly house of this tabernacle be dissolved we have a building of God 2 Corinthians 5:1
  - b. But that does not mean we have attained all knowledge about that subject 2 Peter 3:18
  - c. We should not let knowledge "puff" us up Colossians 2:18; 1 Corinthians 8:1; 1:19-31
- 2. Some do not have the same knowledge 1 Corinthians 8:7
  - a. We must be willing to learn 2 Peter 3:18; Ephesians 4:15
  - b. We must be willing to teach 1 Timothy 3:2; 2 Timothy 2:24
  - c. The mission of the church is to teach Matthew 28:19-20
- 3. Yet I must be careful with this knowledge 1 Corinthians 8:10-12
  - a. Others are watching 1 Corinthians 11:26; Matthews 5:16
    - b. The way I do treat others does effect my eternal destiny Matthew 25:35-45
    - c. Paul said this was what he was willing to do 1 Corinthians 9:19-23
    - d. This is the discipline that we all need 1 Corinthians 9:27
    - e. Christ set the example for us Philippians 2:5-8; Matthew 26:39
- 4. It has to do with love 1 Corinthians 8:1
  - a. I am nothing without love 1 Corinthians 13:2, 3, 4
  - b. Let all things be done with charity 1 Corinthians 16:14

- c. We are to be walking charitably Romans 14:15
- d. Having the proper feelings for one another will results in the proper treatment of one another Philippians 2:1-4
