- c. God hears the petitions, prayers, supplications, intercessions, and giving of thanks 1 Timothy 2:1
- d. Are you part of the righteous?
  - i. You might say that you are.
  - ii. God defines the righteous not men! Psalm 119:137, 138
  - iii. The righteous are those who have been baptized.
    - 1. Were you baptized for the right reason? Joining a religious organization
    - 2. Were you baptized in the right method? Sprinkling or pouring
  - iv. The righteous must live right?
    - 1. What one wears 1 Timothy 2:9
    - 2. What one says Ephesians 4:29
    - 3. What one thinks Proverbs 23:7; 12:5
    - 4. Attitude make the difference in who the righteous are Matthew 5:13-16
    - 5. The righteous can be identified with Christ as belonging to Him. Matthew 25:31-37 (those on the right hand are called righteous: they belong to Christ)
    - 6. The righteous are practicing what they are preaching.
