 - ii. Daniel and the lions den Daniel 6:4, 10, 18-24
 - iii. David and Goliath 1 Samuel 17:24, 26,29, 32-37, 40-47
 - iv. Joseph Genesis 39:21; 41:43

 - a. Yet we should be praying 1 Thessalonians 5:17; Romans 12:12; Colossians 4:2
 - b. This is so important that the disciples asked Jesus to teach them the proper way to pray Luke 11:1
 - c. We are to pray as the Spirit directs us today. Ephesians 6:18 (1 Timothy 4:1; 1 Corinthians 14:37; 2 Peter 1:21)
 - d. There are various kinds of prayers
 - i. Intercessionary prayers 1 Timothy 2:1 Praying for others
 - ii. Thanksgiving 1 Thessalonians 5:18
 - iii. Supplication Philippians 4:6 Petitioning God for our various needs
 - iv. For all saints Ephesians 6:18; James 5:16
 - v. That the Gospel may have its free course 2 Thessalonians 3:1: Acts 4:31; 9:29; 14:3; 19:8
