    - v. We can not let Satan get advantage of us in this matter 2 Corinthian 2:11
  - c. I must forgive as I am forgiven Ephesians 4:32
- 2. The requirements of forgiveness.
  - a. Repentance a change of one's mind, change for the better
  - b. Repentance and remission are tied together Mark 1:4; Luke 24:47
  - c. The question is asked "Must I forgive someone even though they do not repent
    - i. What did Jesus do Luke 23:34
    - ii. What did Stephen do Acts 7:60
    - iii. When was these sins not laid to their charge?
  - d. Confession is necessary Psalm 51:3-4; 1 John 1:9
- 3. The results of forgiveness.
  - a. Sins and iniquities will be remembered no more Jeremiah 31:34; Hebrews 8:12
  - b. Sins be removed as far as the east is from the west Psalm 103:12
  - c. Sins are blotted out Acts 3:19
  - d. Sins are covered Romans 4:7
  - e. Sins are not imputed Romans 4:8; 2 Corinthians 5:19
