- 1. 1 Peter 4:10
- 2. The gift in this passage refers to the miraculous gifts that were passed on by the laying on of the apostles hands. Acts 2:38; 8:17
- 3. These gifts were to be used for to be an attendant, i.e. wait upon (menially or as a host, friend. This is the word defined as minister
- 4. Steward is a person who is in control of another's property. Genesis 39:4; 44:1
- 5. Christians are to be good stewards of the many different graces of God (yes these are singular in number, but the word "manifold" means varied)
- 6. Let us consider some ideas about us being stewards of the property of God

- 1. Why are we stewards?
 - a. Stewards could have been slaves that were placed in this position Genesis 39:4; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; 1 Peter 1:18-19
 - b. Stewards could become one willingly (working for another) 2 Corinthians 8:5 Romans 6:16
 - c. Thus we belong to God.
 - d. In either case we are placed over God's gifts James 1:17; Psalm 127:3; Matthew 25:15; 2 Corinthians 4:7
- 2. Work of the stewards
 - a. Do our best Ecclesiastes 9:10; Colossians 3:23
 - b. We ought to do the most not see how little we can get by with Luke 17:10
 - c. Faithfulness is required 1 Corinthians 4:2
 - d. Our duties must be met and fulfilled Matthew 25: 19-27
- 3. The tasks of the steward
 - a. Preach God's Word Mark 16:15-16; 2 Timothy 4:1-4; Titus 2:1
 - b. Teach Titus 2:4; Matthew 28:19-20; 1 Timothy 1:3; 2 Timothy 2:24
 - c. Benevolence Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 6:18; Titus 2:7
 - d. Visiting James 1:27
- 4. The tools of the steward
 - a. Time Job 14:1-2; James 4:14; Ephesians 5:16; John 9:4
 - b. Influence Romans 14:16; 2 Peter 2:12; 3:15-16; Matthew 5:16
 - c. Ability Matthew 25:15; Romans 12:4-5 (6-8 about 7 different "gifts" are mentioned)
 - d. Money Matthew 25:15, 21, 23; 2 Corinthians 9:6
 - e. Family Psalm 127:3; 1 Timothy 5:8; Ephesians 5:23-33; 1 Peter 3:1-7
 - f. Opportunities Galatians 6:10; Revelation 3:10
- 5. The treasury of our work Ephesians 2:10
 - a. Family 1 Timothy 5:8; Ephesians 6:2; 5:25
 - b. Friends Acts 9:39
 - c. Church Ephesians 3:21
