 - ii. Paul set his goal Colossians 3:1-2
 - iii. He stated that we are to lay side sins that beset us Hebrews 12:1-2
 - iv. Paul's life is worthy to be emulated 1 Corinthians 11:1
 - v. We must seek the kingdom first Matthew 6:33
 - b. We must reach out of our comfort zone
 - i. Paul "reached" and "pressed" Philippians 3:13-14
 - ii. For us this may be studying 2 Timothy 2:15
 - iii. For us this may be praying 1 Thessalonians 5:17; Ephesians 6:18
 - iv. For us this may be talking to someone about their soul 2 Timothy 2:2
 - v. For us this may be doing good for others Galatians 6:10
 - c. We must never give up
 - i. Problems will arise in our life Romans 3:23
 - ii. Paul had to work on this daily 1 Corinthians 9:27
 - iii. Paul suffered much for the cause of Christ 2 Corinthians 11:24-28
 - iv. We are told to be strong, and of good courage Joshua 1:6,7,9; Ephesians 6:10
