Introduction

- 1. Ephesians 5:23-25
- 2. This question has been long disputed in the religious world.
- 3. The popular idea is that one is saved then he joins the church.
- 4. This has led to the idea that the church is unimportant.
- 5. Some say that one can stay at home read their Bible, pray, live a good moral life and go to heaven, without being a member of the church.
- 6. Is this true?
- 7. Let us study from our Bible and see what the answer is.

II Discussion

- 1. The Cross of Christ says no one cannot be saved outside of the church!
 - a. The Cross of our Lord is directly related to the subject of the church Acts 20:28; Ephesians 2:16
 - b. Did our Lord shed His precious blood to purchase a non-essential?
 - c. We cannot separate the blood, the cross, and the church!
- 2. The descriptive language say that no one can be saved outside of the church.
 - a. The "church" means the called out Matthew 16:18; 1 Corinthians 3:11
 - b. The church is the body of Christ Ephesians 1:22-23; 4:4; Colossians 1:18
 - c. The church is the kingdom of Christ Colossians 1:13; Hebrews 12:28; John 18:36
 - d. The church is the household of faith Galatians 6:10; 1 Timothy 3:15; Romans 8:17
 - e. The church is the temple of the Lord 1 Corinthians 3:16-17; Ephesians 2:20-23
- 3. The prophets of old say no, one cannot be saved outside of the church
 - a. Isaiah prophesied that salvation would be in Zion Isaiah 2:2-3; 46:13
 - b. The Hebrew writer identifies Zion with the church Hebrews 12:22-23
 - i. Which are written in heaven, who are these
 - ii. If not written in heaven then you are lost Revelation 20:15; 21:27
 - c. The prophet Isaiah answered our question 2700 years ago.
- 4. The plan of salvation says no, a person cannot be saved outside the church
 - a. The Lord gave this plan Hebrews 5:8-9; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:46-47
 - i. It was to bring salvation to the soul Romans 6:16-18; 1 Pewter 1:22
 - ii. To disobey this plan is doom 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9
 - b. It was preached on Pentecost with great results Acts 2:37-41
 - c. Those who obeyed were added by the Lord to the church Acts 2:47
 - i. It was not an act done by others, there is no voting.
 - ii. There is no exception no soul is left outside
 - iii. The same scripture that prove one is saved is also used to show that one is added to the church Galatians 3:26-27; 1 Corinthians 12:13

III Conclusion

- 1. Jesus is the only Savior Acts 4:12
- 2. When He saves He then adds them to the church Acts 2:47

- 3. Let none of us who are saved thin we can do without membership in the church.
- 4. The church is not a religious luxury added by men but it is a divine necessity for everyone
