Introduction

- 1. Psalm 85:6
- 2. The word "revival" means to keep or make alive, give the promise of life, preserve alive, repair, restore to life; be whole (Strong). Webster to return to consciousness of life to become active or flourishing again, revival an act or instance or reviving; the state of being revived as (a) renewed attention or interest is something (b) a new presentation or publication (c) a period or renewed religious interest.
- 3. In our text we find that they are to be revived again so one can be at a point and fall from that position.
- 4. The word "again" means that it has happened before and thus we conclude that it will happen again.
- 5. Do we need to be revived again?

II Discussion

- 1. We need a revival if the Word is lagging, slowing or dragging Habakkuk 3:2
 - a. We are to be unmovable in our work for the Lord 1 Corinthians 15:58
 - b. We are to be ready for every good work Titus 3:1
 - c. Are we indifferent toward the work of the Lord Revelation 3:15-16
- 2. We need a revival if our attitude toward the church is:
 - a. Critical and faultfinding Ephesians 4:32; Matthew 7:1-3
 - b. We need to be involved in the work if we are.
 - c. Wanting to hurt the church Philippians 2:1-18
 - d. Not loving the brethren 1 John 3:14-18; Hebrews 13:1
- 3. We need a revival personally if:
 - a. We are letting our conscience become seared with a not iron 1 Timothy 4:1-3
 - b. We are permitting wickedness to grow and increase Jeremiah 6:9-17
 - c. If we feel the world pulling at our heart strings 1 John 2:15-17; James 4:4,7; Hebrews 11:24-27
 - d. We are drifting further and further away from God Hebrews 2:1; Hosea 14:1-3

III Conclusion

- 2. Nothing to be ashamed of we all do from time to time, the shame is in doing nothing about it if we do.
- 3. Maybe you have never started serving the Lord now is the time to start serving Him!
