 - a. Do we have our eyes fixed upon it Psalm 74:20
 - b. Are we obeying the commandment of God Psalm 119:6, 15, 117

 - a. God does not pervert judgment upon personal regards, beauty, stature country, parentage, relation, wealth, or honor in the world. Acts 20:34
 - b. God does not save man by their external privileges Romans 2:11
 - c. No one is closer to God than any other Ephesians 6:9
 - d. Not by the Old Law or a man's station in life Colossians 2:16; 3:25
 - e. God does not favor any one cause from personal consideration 1 Peter 1:17

 - a. In our worship
 - b. In our everyday life?
