 - a. It has many meanings: Abundance, wealth, treasure, and honor, dignity of mind or heart, splendor, brightness majesty. The glorious attributes, infinite perfections of God; the bliss of heaven
 - b. The phrase "give glory to God" (Joshua 7:19) means to confess your sins.

 - d. At the announcement of His birth Luke 2:9
 - e. At the mount of Transfiguration Luke 9:28-36
 - f. At the resurrection of Lazarus John 11:40 Psalm 19:1 not always the same kind of manifestation
 - i. John 1:14 at the beginning of His earthly ministry
 - ii. John 2:11 by Him miracles
 - iii. John 12:23; 17:1, 5
- 2. Glory given
 - a. Seen in the Model prayer Matthew 6:9-13
 - i. Psalm 115:1 for His grace and mercy
 - ii. He is our maker
 - iii. We are committing ourselves to Him in life (Romans 12:2) and worship Ephesians 3:21; Romans 11:36
- 3. Glory given to whom?
 - a. Not to or in man 1 Corinthians 1:29-31; 1:12; 4:6; 3:21-23
 - b. This glory is not the same as above and can sometimes mean vain glory
 - c. The word is used in Romans 5:2 in a good sense so the context tells how the word will be used 2 Corinthians 5:12
 - d. We can glory in man and it is sin when we admire too much: physical shape; clothes, skills, position, influence, homes, brains, acquaintances, or whatever they are most proud of and expect applause Romans 12:2 which is your reasonable service.
 - e. God does get the glory? Acts 12:23; 1 Corinthians 10:31; Matthew 5:16
 - f. How do we give God the glory?
 - i. By being in the church Ephesians 3:21
 - ii. When suffering for being a Christian 1 Peter 4:12-13;
 - iii. When we are resurrected Romans 8:16-21
